Incident: 7/27/15 Assist NYSP

Location: Spring St.

Case Info: Patrol responded to assist the New York State Police with an alarm activation on Spring St. Incident turned over to State Police

Incident: 7/28/15 Criminal Mischief Complaint

Location: Townhouse Apts., 3B

Case Info: Patrol responded to a Criminal Mischief Complaint at the Townhouse Apartments. Complainant stated that she came out of her apt. and discovered that one of her windows was broken. It appeared that the window broke due to the very high temperatures in recent days.

Incident: 7/28/15 Assist NYSP

Location: 7115 E. Main St., Town of Hamilton

Case Info: Patrol responded to assist the State Police at 7115 E. Main St., Town of Hamilton for a reported trespass.

Incident: 7/28/15 Assist NYSP

Location: Crow Hill Rd.

Case Info: Patrol responded Crow Hill Rd. to assist NYSP. Upon arrival, patrol assisted with an uncooperative subject. Subject was placed in the rear of another responding unit. No further assistance required.

Incident: 7/29/15 Alarm Activation

Location: 46 Broad St.

Case Info: Patrol responded to a reported alarm activation at 46 Broad St. Upon arrival, patrol was told it was a false trip of the alarm.

Incident: 7/29/15 Property Damage Hit and Run Accident

Location: Byrne Dairy, 31 Utica St.

Case Info: Patrol received a complaint of a property damage hit & run accident to his vehicle, which was parked at the Byrne Dairy, 31 Utica St. After about an hour of searching, patrol located the vehicle and it's owner. A check of the owner and vehicle discovered that Karri Ryan (owner) had a suspended driver's license. Ryan was ticketed for Aggravated Unlicensed Operation 3rd, Unsafe Backing and Leaving the Scene of a Property Damage Accident.

Incident: 7/30/15 Criminal Mischief Complaint

Location: Maple Ave.

Case Info: Patrol received a complaint regarding a Criminal Mischief to a vehicle that occurred overnight. Upon arrival, patrol spoke to the owner, Kathleen Rhodes. Rhodes came out to her vehicle in the morning and noticed that there were scratches along the entire length of her vehicle and her windshield wiper was snapped right off the windshield. There were also vulgar words scratched into the paint. An investigation was carried out and a suspect, Jacob Holcomb admitted to doing the damage. Holcomb was arrested for Criminal Mischief 2nd, which is a Felony.

Location: E. Broad St

Case Info: Nathan E. Burgess was arrested for Disorderly Conduct after patrol witnessed him urinating in the street.

Location: 11 Lebanon St.
