Incident: 8/5/15 Seized Property

Location: Oliveri's, Lebanon St.

Case Info: Patrol observed a white male walk into Oliveri's. When the male went to pay for his lunch, patrol saw a pistol grip hanging out of his right pocket. Upon investigation, it was found that the pistol was an airsoft pistol. Patrol confiscated the pistol and contacted the parent to come and retrieve it. No charges filed.

Incident: 8/5/15 Property Damage MVA

Location: Utica @ Broad St.

Case Info: Patrol responded to a 2-car property damage MVA and the intersection of Utica and Broad Sts. A vehicle operated by Mark S. McCormick was traveling south on Utica St. and attempted to turn left onto Payne St. A vehicle operated by John W. Vondauber was traveling north on Broad St, proceeding to Madison St. Mr. McCormick's vehicle struck Vondauber's vehicle in the right front fender. McCormick was ticketed for Failure to Yield Right-of-Way.

Incident: 8/5/15 Property Damage MVA

Location: McDonald's parking lot

Case Info: Patrol responded to a 2-car property damage MVA in the McDonald's parking lot on Utica St. A vehicle operated by Wayne A. Smith was in line at the drive-through when it was struck by a vehicle operated by Edwin D. Heath, Jr. There was minor damage to the Smith vehicle and no tickets were issued.

Incident: 8/6/15 Property Damage MVA

Location: Coop, upper parking lot

Case Info: Patrol responded to a 2-car property damage MVA. Cindy L. Wilcox had parked her vehicle at the Coop. Around 10 a.m., she came out to her vehicle and noticed the passenger side mirror was folded in toward the window. She also noticed dents in the passenger side door with black paint transfer.
