Incident: 8/24/15 Found Property

Location: Hamilton Police Dept.

Case Info: Upon returning to the PD from patrol, patrol observed a brown leather wallet lodged in the handle of the interior door. Property was logged in and a report completed. On 8/27/15, the wallet was turned over to Colgate Campus Safety per the owner's request.

Incident: 8/28/15 Underage Drinking

Location: Lebanon St.

Case Info: While on routine patrol, Piper A. McCabe, was observed on Lebanon St. with an open 12 oz. can of Keystone Light Beer. Ms. McCabe produced an ID showing that she was under 21. McCabe was charged with Possession of Open Container in Public and Alcohol Possession Under 21. She is to appear in Hamilton Village Court on September 21, 2015 at 5:00 p.m. to answer the charges.

Incident: 8/28/15 Property Damage Hit & Run MVA

Location: Lally Lane

Case Info: Xi Chun was operating vehicle 1 and was pulling into a parking space, striking vehicle 2 (parked). Chun exited her vehicle to inspect the damage. Upon returning to her vehicle, she backed out causing more damage to vehicle 2, then left the scene. Chun was located shortly thereafter and asked for her driver's license and registration. Chun produced a permit only and could not produce a registration or insurance card. The vehicle was recently purchased from a student who had left the country. Because patrol could not determine if the previous owner had authorized Chun to operate the vehicle, the vehicle was towed by ProTow.

Location: Lebanon St.

Case Info: Patrol found personal property on Lebanon St. and returned it to the owner.

---

Incident: 8/28/15 Disorderly Conduct/Possession of Forged Instrument

Location: Utica St.

Case Info: While on routine patrol, Matthew A. Kane was observed urinating in the alleyway between Byrne Dairy and the Palace Theater. Upon asking Kane for identification, patrol observed a second form of ID, which proved to be a forged Maryland driver's license. Kane was arrested for Criminal Possession of a Forged Instrument 3<sup>rd</sup> and Disorderly Conduct. Kane is to appear in Hamilton Village Court on September 21, 2015 at 5:00 p.m. to answer the charges.

---

Incident: 8/28/15 Criminal Possession of Controlled Substance

Location: Broad St.

Case Info: While on foot patrol on Broad St., patrol observed Andrew P. Schwartz standing on the sidewalk holding a partial 18 pk of Miller Lite Beer. Patrol was familiar with Schwartz and knew he was under 21. Schwartz initially refused to comply with patrol's request and appeared to be under the influence of some unknown substance. Schwartz was taken to the police station for processing. Patrol checked Schwartz's eyes, which were dilated. Schwartz's behavior continued to be abnormal. Upon searching Schwartz's wallet, patrol located some paper strips and aluminum foil which was suspected to be LSD. Schwartz confirmed the strips were LSD. After being Mirandized, Schwartz was arrested for Criminal Possession of Controlled Substance 4<sup>th</sup> (Hallucinogen), Criminal Possession of Forged Instrument 3<sup>rd</sup> and Unlawful Possession Alcohol Under 21. Schwartz was arraigned before Acting Village Justice Donald W. Haight and remanded to Madison County Jail on \$5000.00 cash/\$10,000 secured bond. Schwartz is scheduled to reappear in Hamilton Village Court on September 14, 2015 to continue with his arraignment.
