11/16/2015

Incident: 10/27/15 Car/Deer MVA

Location: Broad St.

Case Info: Patrol responded to a car/deer accident on Broad St. /Rte. 12B. Ashley Crandall reported that a deer jumped in front of her car as she was traveling north.

Incident: 10/28/15 Road Hazard

Location: Lebanon St.

Case Info: Patrol responded to a reported road hazard on Lebanon St. Upon arrival patrol observed some cow entrails scattered across the road. Entrails removed.

Incident: 10/26/15 Assist to MCSO

Location: Madison Marketplace 12B

Case Info: Patrol assisted MCSO with a call at the Madison Marketplace on 12B. No further information available.

Incident: 10/31/15 Property Damage MVA

Location: Pine St./Maple Ave.

Case Info: Patrol responded to a 2-car property damage MVA at the intersection of Pine St. and Maple Ave. Timothy Cassidy was sound bound on Maple Ave. As he went through the intersection, Bruce Donker started to enter Maple Ave. from Pine St. Donker failed to yield the right-of-way and struck Cassidy's vehicle causing damage to the front end. 11/1/15 Criminal Mischief Complaint

Location: 10 College St.

Case Info: Lavinia Nicolae reported that an unknown person hit the front window of the residence using a room for rent sign. The screen and window glass were broken. The for rent sign had originally been in the front yard. No suspect(s) identified at this time.

Location: 10 W. Kendrick Ave.

Case Info: Sara Solomen contacted patrol regarding the larceny of property at 10 W. Kendrick Ave. There are no suspects at this time and Solomen did not wish to pursue prosecution.

Location: College St.

11/6/15 Criminal Possession of Forged Instrument 3rd

Location: Risky Business 11 Lebanon St.

Case Info: While on foot patrol in the area of Risky Business, Patrol observed Jacob Stonecipher, who patrol knew to be 20 years of age, sitting in the bar drinking an alcoholic beverage. Location: Tyler Field Parking Lot

Case Info: Yesu Carter contacted 911 stating that his vehicle's license plate and bracket had been removed from his vehicle and placed on the hood of the car. Upon investigation, it showed that there was no damage to the vehicle and it appeared that someone had struck the vehicle or removed the plate and bracket and placed it on the hood of the car.
