HAMILTON POLICE BLOTTER:

10/20/2015

Incident: 10/1/15 Suspended Registration

Location: Utica St.

Case Info: Patrol conducted a traffic stop (using the License Plate Reader) on Utica St. involving Chuck Fox. It was determined that Mr. Fox's registration had expired. Mr. Fox was issued a ticket for Operating with a Suspended Registration and is to appear in Hamilton Village Court to answer the charge.

Incident: 10/2/15 Criminal Possession of Forged Instrument and Disorderly Conduct

Location: Utica St.

Case Info: Patrol observed a male subject, identified as Tycen A. Better, urinating on the sidewalk in front of #10 Tavern. Upon asking for identification, Mr. Better produced 2 forms of ID, one of which was a forged driver's license. Mr. Better was charged with Criminal Possession of Forged Instrument 3rd and Disorderly Conduct. He appeared in Hamilton Village Court on Monday, October 19, 2015 to answer the charges.

Incident: 10/2/15 Suspended Registration

Location: Broad St.

Case Info: Patrol conducted a traffic stop (using the License Plate Reader) on Broad St. involving an individual named Townsed. Townsed was issued a ticket for having a Suspended Registration and is to appear in Hamilton Village Court to answer the charge.

Incident: 10/3/15

Location: Utica St. Suspended Registration and Aggravated Unlicensed Operation

Case Info: Patrol conducted a traffic stop (using the License Plate Reader) on Utica St. involving Ryan Bean. A check of his DLIC showed that his registration and license were suspended. Bean was issued tickets for Operating while Registration Suspended and Aggravated Unlicensed Operation 3rd. Bean is to appear in Hamilton Village Court to answer the charges.

Incident: 10/4/15 Unattended Death

Location: Rte. 12B

Case Info: Patrol responded to the report of an unattended death at 2307 Rte. 12B. There was a DNR order in effect and the deceased female was pronounced by Madison Ambulance medic Rhodes. Madison County ADA on call was notified and female was released to the funeral home.

Incident: 10/6/15 911 Hang-up Call

Location: Madison Market Place

Case Info: Patrol responded to assist Madison County Sheriff's Office with a 911 hang-up call at Bassett Healthcare; Madison Market Place.

10/6/15 Petit Larceny

Location: 5 Maple Ave.

Case Info: Patrol was dispatched to 5 Maple Ave. for a reported Petit Larceny. Upon arrival, patrol met with Linda Cadwell, owner of Hamilton Power Equipment. Linda reported that she noticed 2 of her No Parking signs had been stolen from the overhead door on her business. She declined prosecution but requested extra patrols in the area.

10/7/15 Concern for Welfare

Location: 13 Wylie St.

Case Info: Patrol received information from Madison County Sheriff's Office of a possible threat against John Flagg. Patrol checked on Flagg to be sure he was ok. Case closed.

10/8/15 Larceny Complaint

Location: 20 Lebanon St.

Case Info: Patrol was dispatched in The Hour Glass, 20 Lebanon St., for a larceny not in progress. Upon arrival, patrol spoke to Lindsay Kenyon who stated that the theft involved 2 white males who stole a bottle of Jameson from behind the bar. Patrol was shown a video of the incident and requested that a copy be burned for the file. The owner, Thomas Hodge, declined prosecution but stated that if the 2 males returned to the bar, he would ban them.

10/10/15 Suspended Registration

Location: Madison St.

Case Info: Patrol conducted a traffic stop after being alerted by the License Plate Reader, that a vehicle that had just passed had a suspended registration. The operator of the vehicle was a Wayne A. Burmaster. A check of the operator's DLIC showed that the registration was suspended for insurance not in effect. Burmaster is to appear in Hamilton Village Court on November 2, 2015 to answer the charge.

Location: Broad St.
