Incident: 9/22/15 Found Property

Location: Hamilton Police Department

Case Info: Matthew Bailey came to the Police Department to turn in a Mac Pro Book that he found. Property receipt was completed and Mac Pro Book placed in temporary evidence locker.

Incident: 9/23/15 Burglary Complaint

Location: Dunkin Donuts

Case Info: Patrol responded to a reported burglary not in progress at Dunkin Donuts. A review of security video showed 2 individuals who had entered the store. After completing a preliminary investigation, patrol arrested Addison Gray for Burglary 3rd, Conspiracy 6th and Petit Larceny. The other individual was a juvenile. Gray was arraigned before Judge Bogan in Hamilton Village Court and remanded to his mother's custody. Gray is to reappear in Hamilton Village Court at a later date.

Incident: 9/26/15 Alcohol Possession Under 21

Location: Broad St.

Case Info: While on routine foot patrol on Broad St., patrol observed Saurabh Bhatia toss a bag containing a liquid into a tree in front of a residence. The liquid turned out to be wine. Bhatia was uncooperative and was taken to the station. A check of his ID showed that he was under 21. Bhatia was arrested for Littering and Alcohol Possession Under 21. He is to appear in Hamilton Village Court on October 19th at 5:00 p.m. to answer the charges.

Incident: 9/26/15 Marijuana Possession

Location: Utica St.

Case Info: While on foot patrol on Utica St., patrol observed 4 males sitting outside the closed Dunkin Donuts. Patrol approached the males to find out their business there because of a recent burglary at the business. Upon approaching the group, patrol detected a strong odor of marijuana. William G. Jundanian was in possession of a burning marijuana joint, which he threw on the ground as patrol approached. Patrol searched Jundanian and found a 2.50 ml bottle of alcohol along with his ID which showed him to be under 21. Jundanian was arrested for Criminal Possession of Marijuana 5th and Alcohol Possession Under 21. He also had in his possession a license that was not his own. He was also arrested for

Use of Another's license. Jundanian is to appear in Hamilton Village Court on October 19th at 5:00 p.m. to answer the charges.

Incident: 9/26/15 Police Assistance

Location: Morrisville, NY

Case Info: Patrol Units 842 and 801 responded to a county-wide law enforcement call for assistance in the Village of Morrisville. Upon arrival, patrol observed approximately 250 angry students in the road on Main St. A fight was in progress at 44 E. Main St. Patrol assisted with dispersing the crowd. Once the situation was under control, patrol cleared the area and returned to routine patrol.

Incident: 9/21/15 Mental Health Issue

Location: Maple Ave.

Case Info: Patrol responded to a reported mental health issue. A female subject had reportedly taken a large number of sleeping pills in hopes of "never waking up". Subject was transported to Hamilton Hospital for immediate medical attention and then transported to CPEP for further evaluation.
